'Greek' finds its groove

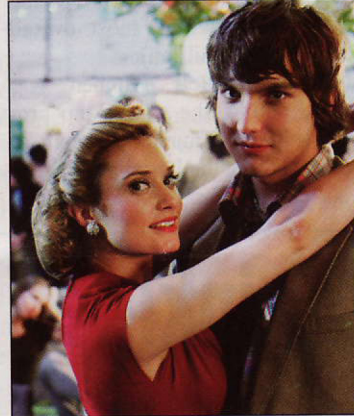
It's all "Greek" to ABC Family, which has picked up 10 more episodes of the college-set drama.

ABC Family initially greenlit 10 segs of "Greek"; the additional order, confirmed Tuesday, brings the show's season-one tally up to 20 episodes.

The new episodes will run on the cabler in early 2008. Four episodes of "Greek" have run so far; the show continues to grow in ABC Family's core female 12-34 demo, averaging 476,000 viewers in the measurement last week.

"Greek" has received additional runs on the cabler's sister ABC broadcast web as well.

Show, from Piller/Segan, revolves around a group of students who struggle to adapt to college life while navigating the world of fraternities and sororities. Patrick Sean Smith created and co-exec produces "Greek," while Shawn Piller and

Lloyd Segan exec produce. Gil Junger directed the series pilot.
